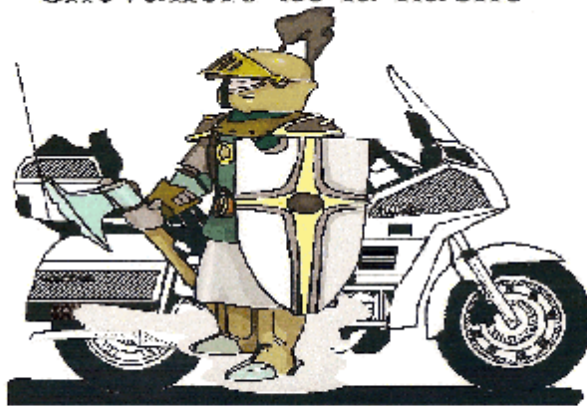

#### RECIPES:

##### Easy Apple Crisp

You may need to adjust the amount of sugar for the amount of sweetness in the apples you use. 4 to 5 medium cooking apples, peeled, cored and sliced.

3 to 4 tablespoons of sugar.

½ teaspoon of cinnamon

Dash of salt.

Topping:

¾ cup all-purpose flour

1/3 cup of butter (margarine)

¾ cup packed brown sugar

¼ cup of oats

½ teaspoon cinnamon

¼ cup chopped nuts

Mix apples with sugar, cinnamon and a touch of salt. Place in 8" greased square baking pan. For the topping, in a medium bowl, mix together flour, sugar, cinnamon, oats and nuts. Cut in butter Using a pastry blender or cross cutting with two knives, until you have coarse crumbs. Sprinkle the Topping over the apples.

Bake at 375' for 35 to 45 minutes, or until apples are tender and crumbs are golden. Serve with whipped topping or ice cream
